Epilepsy Southwestern Ontario provides a range of services that help teachers and school staff accommodate children with epilepsy and seizure disorders.

Teacher Education Presentation- Epilepsy Educators teach school staff about epilepsy, seizure first aid, medication side effects and learning strategies for children with epilepsy. Educational videos and PowerPoint format are used, as well as, resource materials for each school are provided. Presentations range from 30 – 60 minutes based on time allotted. All presentations require access to a SMARTboard or computer, speakers and data projector.

School Safety Plans & Seizure Response Protocols- Epilepsy Educators help develop an individualized seizure response protocol to address each specific student's seizure related safety. Educators will also work with the school to ensure every child with epilepsy is accommodated as needed.
