Designed to increase knowledge about seizures and decrease stigma, this presentation meets specific expectations of the Grade 5 Ontario Catholic Curriculum. The facilitator uses props, EEGs, the *Famous People Game*, video clips and an interactive demonstration to reinforce specific expectations.
